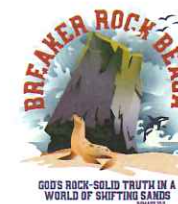

Operating under a new brand 'Life Options: Sexual Wellness | Informed Choices | Education,' the life-saving ministry will offer the same services currently offered at its Trenton, Missouri location. While the services offered will likely roll out in phases, initial services could include medical grade pregnancy tests, options counseling, limited 1st-trimester ultrasounds, as well as STD/STI testing and treatment. All services will be free of charge and offered in a safe, confidential, judgment-free atmosphere. Trained, licensed medical personnel will be utilized in the new medical facility. Life Options exists to encourage individuals to explore options and make life affirming choices concerning pregnancy and sexual health through compassionate care, education, evangelism and mentorship.

Life Options is a 501c3 nonprofit organization depending solely on individual donations and private grants. 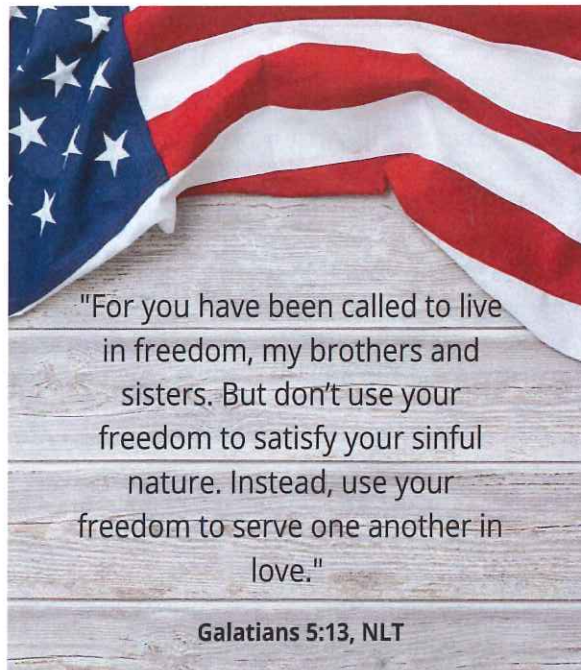
